Verse 1

- 1. The third year of Cyrus is **536** BC.
- 2. This is Daniel's **FINAL** vision.
- 3. The fulfillment will be a long way in the **FUTURE**: "the time appointed was long."

<u>Verses 2 & 3</u>

4. In the Hebrew it is written "three full weeks *of days*". We don't need this, because we know that he wasn't fasting for 21 years, so why did Daniel add "*of days*"?

<u>Verses 4-12</u>

- 5. When were the words of Daniel heard? **FROM THE FIRST DAY**
- 6. Why did it take three weeks for the angel to answer? Read on.

Verse 13

- 7. Who is the "prince of Persia"? A FALLEN ANGEL
- 8. Who came to help? **MICHAEL**

Verse 14

- 9. Who is the vision for? **DANIEL'S PEOPLE**
- 10. When shall the vision be fulfilled? IN THE LATTER DAYS
- 11. How long until the vision is fulfilled? MANY DAYS

<u>Verses 15-21</u>

- 12. Do Satan and his workers try to affect world policy? Who is the 'god of this world'?
- 13. The 'scripture of truth' that this angel speaks about. Is it already written? Before Daniel wrote it? Psalm 119:89 says, "For ever, O Lord, thy word is settled in heaven."
