1.	"And at that time" What time? As Daniel 11:40 reads, "at the time of the end". I believe that will stand up halfway through the tribulation period, during the Abomination of Desolation.
2.	Who are the "children of thy people"? Daniel is the one receiving this vision, so it is Daniel's people whom we are talking about, the
3.	The "Tribulation", the last 3½ years, the "time of Jacob's trouble", as we read in Jeremiah 30:7, "Alas! For that day is great, so that none is like it: it is even the time of Jacob's trouble; but he shall be saved out of it." In Daniel 12:1 we see that it is a "time of trouble, such as never was since there was a nation even to that same time".
4.	Who shall be delivered? Certain Jews. "Every one that shall be found written in the book". What book? The

7.	Those that awake to everlasting contempt will have to wait more years, and then will appear before the Great Throne.

9.	Daniel is told to shut up the words and the book. The Apostle John, in the Book of Revelation, was told, "Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at handBehold, I come quickly" (Revelation 22:10-12a)

14. 1,290 days from the abomination of desolation a certain event will happen. What is it? Anything I say would be a random guess. We are not told. This event will occur days into the Millennial reign of Christ.	
Verse 12	
15. Forty-five days after the unknown event in verse 11, there will be another event that will occur. This is 2 ½ months into the Millennial Kingdom.	
Verse 13	
16. "Thou shalt rest", refers to Daniel's Daniel will "stand in thy lot at the end of the days." Daniel stood before many kings on the earth, but his true lot in life is to stand before the King of kings, Jesus Christ.
